

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ANGELICA VILLAGE BOARD

MARCH 28, 2019

HELD AT THE ANGELICA HOSE CO. NO. 1

VILLAGE BOARD PRESENT: Mayor Michael Trivisondoli; Trustees: Robert Claypool, Jane Tylenda and Todd Haggstrom

Mayor Trivisondoli called the special meeting to order at 6:30pm.

The line officers explained to the board the changes that have occurred over the years to the Ambulance Department and the requirements for training.

The department only has three (3) volunteers that are trained for ALS and due to the state mandates to renew they have elected not to do so.

The Angelica Hose Co. No. 1 would like to recommend the Board of Trustees contract out for ALS Service to offer the best care possible to taxpayers. The department will still provide basic ambulance service to the community and all contracting towns.

Medical Transport System (MTS) out of Scio, New York, would be willing to sit in Angelica for the next three (3) months to provide the ALS coverage to the Angelica territory as they would be interested in entering a contract with the Village of Angelica.

Mayor Trivisondoli motioned to approve a temporary three (3) month trial with MTS for their ambulance to be located in the village and serve our ambulance territory starting April 1, 2019 for all ALS calls – second Trustee Tylenda – Claypool-Aye, Tylenda-Aye, Haggstrom-Aye, Trivisondoli-Aye – carried.

Will schedule a meeting with MTS to discuss possible agreement - April 9, 2019 at the Angelica Hose Co. No. 1 at 7:00 PM.

With no further business to discuss Trustee Haggstrom motioned to adjourn at 7:42pm – second Trustee Tylenda-Claypool-Aye, Tylenda-Aye, Haggstrom-Aye, Trivisondoli-Aye – carried.
