Mayor Trivisonoli called the public hearing to order at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Trivisonoli gave an overview of the draft ATV Law.

There will be no bikes allowed, helmets must be worn at all times, all traffic laws must be followed, if you are caught in a violation there will be fines, all ATV owners must purchase yearly a new sticker, there will be no trail system meaning there will be some streets closed.

All drivers have to have a driver's license, all 14-16 y/o must have a licensed driver with them at all times. The riding time is from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm with a speed limit of 20 mph.

All questions were answered.

All in attendance was in favor of the board passing an ATV local law, received three written statements 2 in favor, 1 not in favor of Main Street being included.

Trustee Tylenda motioned to close the public hearing on the ATV Law comments at 7:40 pm – second Trustee Claypool – Claypool-Aye, Perry-Aye, Tylenda-Aye, Haggstrom-Aye, Trivisonoli-Aye – carried.
